Scholarship Overview

The Perkins Alumni Scholarship is given by the Perkins Alumni and Friends Association to recognize and financially assist a Perkins senior whose parent or grandparent is a Pirate alumnus. The recipient must be attending a two or four year college or university and demonstrate academic excellence, community involvement, and extracurricular participation.

At least two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded.

Selection of Recipients

A committee of Perkins Alumni will review the applications and interview applicants at the Perkins Alumni & Friends Association Building (located on Taylor Road at the NASA entrance). The recipients will be recognized on scholarship night.

There will be a brief 15 minute interview with the committee the afternoon/evening of **Sunday, March 25th**. (If there are more than ten (10) applicants, the Scholarship Committee reserves the right to pre-screen and limit the maximum number of interviews to ten (10).)

The School will schedule your interview time. Please check with the school for your scheduled interview time by **Friday, March 23rd**.

How to Obtain an Application

Applications are available in the Perkins High School counselor's office. The applications must be returned to the same office by **Tuesday, March 20th**.

Applicants ***must*** submit a resume with their application.

Payment of Scholarship Award

Payment is awarded directly to the student upon proof of a payment to their respective institution equal to or greater than the scholarship amount. The Recipients will be recognized at the alumni association's annual chicken barbeque.
