High school students can gain state recognition for exceeding Ohio's graduation requirements through an Academic Honors Diploma. High-level coursework, college and career readiness tests and real-world experiences challenge students.

Students must meet all but one of the following criteria, for the classes of 2018 and beyond. Students must meet general graduation requirements to qualify for honors diplomas.

\_\_\_ 1. Maintain an overall high school cumulative grade point average of at least 3.5 on a four-point scale up to the last grading period of the senior year.

\_\_\_ 2. Obtain a composite score of 27\* on the American College Testing program's ACT tests(excluding the optional writing test) or an equivalent combined score on the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) of 1280\* (excluding the required writing section). Student's highest ACT/SAT \_\_\_\_\_

\_\_\_ 3. Earn 4 units of English

\_\_\_ 4. Earn 4 units of mathematics, which shall include Algebra I, Algebra II, and Geometry and another higher level course, or complete a four-year sequence of courses that contains equivalent content.

\_\_\_ 5. Earn 4 units of science, which shall include 1 unit of biology and 2 units of advanced science

\_\_\_ 6. Earn 4 units of social studies.

\_\_\_ 7. Earn either 3 units of one foreign language or 2 units each of two foreign languages.

\_\_\_ 8. Earn 1 unit of fine arts.
