

The JoAnn Sandra (Weiland) Lang Scholarship Description

In 1962, JoAnn Weiland was awarded her diploma as part of the second graduating class from Perkins High School. Although certainly talented enough to have furthered her education immediately after graduation, limited family resources and cultural factors prevented her from doing so.

The offering of this scholarship is intended as a tribute from those of us who were fortunate enough to have known and loved her. It is also our way enabling today's young women with an opportunity that JoAnn did not have - and is a form of thanks to the many kind and devoted health care professionals who helped to ease the burdens of her life's final journey.

For 2018 we are offering one scholarship in the amount of \$2000. If the applicant is deemed exceptional, this amount could be supplemented by as much as an additional \$1000.

The scholarship will be given once current proof of acceptance at a postsecondary institution is provided to the Treasurer, Perkins Local Schools. Payment will be made directly to the educational institution.

The JoAnn Sandra (Weiland) Lang Scholarship Qualifications

Our criteria is for the scholarship to go to a female student who intends to pursue a major - for a two or more year degree - in a health care related field. This could be anything from being a nurse's aid to high level research. We would like for potential applicants to maintain a cumulative high school grade point average of at least 2.9 on a four point scale, and a senior year to date (of awarding the scholarship) average of at least 3.125. We would expect that student applicants be taking mostly classes that would be considered college prep.

We believe that part of being a health care professional involves personal initiative and leadership. Leadership, to us, means having the resolve to set a good example. As a prospective health care professional, would expect that the applicant be able to demonstrate a commitment to *their own* health. As such, a demonstrated commitment to personal nutrition, health, and fitness through curricular and extracurricular courses or activities may also be considered in this award.
