Application Guidelines:

1. The student must apply through the Guidance Office
2. The student must submit the completed application to the Guidance Office
3. The student is to write an essay:
 - a. The topic of the essay is, *What Does Community Service Mean to Me?*
 - b. The essay is to be between 250-350 words in length
4. The scholarship winner is required to attend a Sandusky Lions Club meeting and read his/her essay to the membership
5. The scholarship check will then be issued, payable to the winning student after they submit a receipt from the college for payment
