COMMUNITY AMBASSADOR SCHOLARSHIP

Purpose: To honor and support students who have demonstrated scholastic excellence, exemplary leadership, and community service. One grant in the amount of \$1,000.00 will be awarded.

1. The applicant must be a graduating senior of Perkins Local Schools.
2. The applicant must have attended Perkins Local Schools continually for at least 2 years.
3. The applicant must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or above.
4. The applicant must have demonstrated leadership ability and exemplary citizenship through community involvement.
5. The applicant must be seeking higher education at a two or four year college or university.
6. Applicant must supply a short essay (1-2 pages typed) that addresses the following topics:
 - a. Share ways that you have served your community during high school.
 - b. Identify one need or challenge you see in the community. Then give an example of how you and/or others in the community might be able to help address that need/challenge.
 - c. Include "What leadership means to me." Be specific with examples of your leadership.
7. The scholarship will be given once current proof of acceptance at a postsecondary institution is provided to the Treasurer, Perkins Local Schools.
8. Payment will be made directly to the educational institution.
