



Local 1216 Scholarship

Local 1216's Education Committee is sponsoring two scholarships, an "at-large" scholarship, which will be drawn at random for \$500, and an essay based scholarship for \$1000, awarded for the best essay written.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be child, grandchild, or legal dependent of current member or retired member of Local 1216. Current member must be a member in good standing and have at least one (1) year seniority.

Qualifications:

An applicant must be a graduating high school senior or current higher education student continuing schooling in the upcoming year. Applicant must be maintaining a GPA of at least 2.5 when applying for scholarship.

Forms:

Please attach current transcript with GPA, a current photograph, a copy of the acceptance letter from the school applicant will be attending, and legibly complete and sign application for scholarship.

If applying for the essay scholarship, attach an essay of *The Importance of Buying Union Made or American Made Products*. Any missing part of the total application process can be cause for rejection of the application.

Selection of Winners:

Deadline for all applications will be March 30th, 2018.

All applicants will be verified by Education Committee. Drawing of the Scholarship-at-Large winner will be selected at random by the Chairman of Local 1216 at the April executive board meeting. The winner of the Essay scholarship will also be awarded at the April membership meeting with the winner of the Scholarship-at-Large winner. The essay will be judged by an educator outside of Local 1216.

Local 1216 Scholarship

- Applicants must be child, grandchild, or legal dependent of current member or retired member of Local 1216. Current member must be a member in good standing and have at least one (1) year seniority.
- Courses must be completed with at least a 2.5 GPA or better each semester.
- Applicants will be required to *completely* fill out and sign scholarship application and write a one page essay on *The Importance of Buying American or Union Made Products* to be turned in no later than **March 30th, 2018**. The winner will be selected by an educator outside of the union and receive a \$1000 scholarship towards their tuition.
- Winners must take at least 12 credit hours each semester or be classified as a full time student.
- The award will be distributed in two payments; half will be disbursed in August for the fall semester. The other half will be dispersed in January, provided the student has maintained the scholarship requirements. It is the student's responsibility to provide proof of academic status to the Education Committee or the UAW Financial Secretary by **December 28th, 2018**. Failure to meet this requirement may result in the forfeiture of the award.
- Past UAW Local 1216 Scholarship winners will be **INELIGIBLE** to reapply.

UAW Scholarship-at-Large

- Applicants must be child, grandchild, or legal dependent of current member or retired member of Local 1216. Current member must be a member in good standing and have at least one (1) year seniority.
- Courses must be completed with at least a 2.5 GPA or better each semester.
- Applicants must fill out application *completely* and submit it to Local 1216 union hall no later than **March 30th, 2018**.
- One winner will be drawn at random by an elected official and be awarded a \$500 scholarship.
- Winners must take at least 12 credit hours each semester or be classified as a full time student.
- The award will be distributed in two payments; half will be disbursed in August for the first semester. The other half will be dispersed in January, provided the student has maintained the scholarship requirements. It is the student's responsibility to provide proof of academic status to the Education Committee or the UAW Financial Secretary by **December 28th, 2018**. Failure to meet this requirement may result in the forfeiture of the award.
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
