# 2018 GUIDELINES FOR WALTER H. ULMER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

**PURPOSE:** To recognize children and grandchildren of active and/or retired members of Local 913, who have demonstrated excellence in academics, a commitment to community service, participation in volunteer and extracurricular activities, held leadership positions and shown a willingness to continue their education after graduating from high school.

**STANDARDS:** One (1) \$2,000.00 scholarship and two (2) \$500.00 scholarships; to children or grandchildren of members attending a college, university or technical school.

1. MUST be a child, grandchild, or legal ward of an active or retired Local 913 member in good standing.
2. MUST be a graduating high school senior and attending classes on a full-time basis in the Summer or Fall of 2018.
3. First and Second alternates will be selected by lottery from all participants.

## SCHOLARSHIP LOTTERY GUIDELINES:

1. Activities including school participation in clubs, athletics, & organizations (6 points); outside activities such as volunteer work, community service, & church activities (8 points); leadership qualities demonstrated by being a counselor, officer, or coach (2 points). (Total = 16 points)
2. A brief essay of your career plans and goals. (6 points)
3. Your high school grade point average and letter grade, verified by the school counselor in writing. (4 points)
4. ACT (17+) or SAT (900+) scores. (1 point)
5. Applicants will receive points based on the guidelines above. The applications will be scored by representatives from local educational institutions and other community leaders.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Applications will be available during an four week period, April 1 - April 27, 2018. Applications may be obtained from your Unit Work Center or Local 913 Hall.
2. Completed applications must be signed by the President, Unit Chairperson, Recording Secretary, or Financial Secretary.
3. All applications must be returned to the Financial Secretary no later than April 27, 2018.
