Admission Standards

Admission standards will be comparable to 2019-20. Students need the required GPA plus scores on one of the following tests:

GPA 2.5

ACT-20 Composite

OR

Accuplacer-250 Next Generation Reading Comprehension

Students who do not meet the college-ready score may go through the Gateway Review process if they have a 3.0 GPA and at least a 243 on the Reading Comprehension Accuplacer. Students will not be admitted with a Reading score below 243.

Accuplacer cut off scores for placement into MATH123, MATH141, PHYS 250 and CHEM130 will be provided once determined by the Math and Chemistry departments. Students will be required to take the Next Generation Advanced Algebra and Functions for Math and Physics and a Chemistry placement test for CHEM130.

Students enrolled in UF CCP courses in 2018-2019 do not need to submit new test scores unless needed as a prerequisite for a course.

Accuplacer Testing

We will administer the Accuplacer test at your school one time between February 5 and May 15. Please contact Rebecca Hillman to schedule a date. (hillman@findlay.edu) Ph: 419-434-4738. There will be on-campus testing sessions as well, and we will notify you of these dates when they are established. Students will also have the option of providing us with Accuplacer scores from tests taken at another testing site.

CollegeBoard will no longer allow students to use Chromebooks for testing without the device being set in Kiosk Mode. If needed, the new Chromebook policy from CollegeBoard can be provided.

Student Application

All students who are interested in taking a UF CCP course during the 2019-20 school year, including students who took or are taking a UF CCP course this year, must complete the online application by June 1, 2019. The link to the application is

Late applications will only be accepted upon written request from the school counselor or principal.

Transcripts and Test Scores

We will need current transcripts for all students who apply. Transcripts should be sent to Rebecca Hillman in the admissions office by June 1, 2019. Test scores submitted by the school (ACT, SAT, and Accuplacer scores that were not administered by UF) should also be sent to Rebecca Hillman by June 1.

Test scores do not need to be submitted for students enrolled in a UF CCP course in 2018/19 (*unless needed for course placement*).

Course Registration Sheets and Class Lists

Course selection sheets, signed by the parent and school counselor, should be submitted to Rebecca Hillman by June 1. Class lists should also be submitted by that date.

Google Doc

This year we are planning to give you access to a Google Doc listing all of your students who have submitted an application, along with columns showing what we have received for that student, as well as his/her acceptance status. We hope this will facilitate communication and exchange of information so that no students fall through the cracks.

Verification of Class Lists

UF class rosters will be sent to you by mid-August for your verification. Rosters must be finalized by September 13, 2019.
